

# HOSPITAL VISITATION

- Visitation hours will be from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm by appointment only. Visitors will need to call ahead of time to schedule the time that they would like to visit.
- 2 (two) visitors at a time for each patient.
- No children 12 years or younger are allowed to visit at this time.
- Visitors will need to be screened prior to visit. If they have been in close contact with a positive case or are exhibiting any COVID symptoms, they will not be allowed visitation.
- Masks will be worn while in the facility at ALL times. Failure to do so will result in termination of visit for that day.
- Visitors will not be allowed to roam in the halls or visit other patients.
- End of life visitation will remain the same with 2 (two) support persons that may enter the facility as long as they pass the screening process. Additional persons may be allowed if approved. Masks are still required.
- OB will remain the same. No visitors except for the 1 (one) support person. (Unless an additional support person is needed and pre-approved by the Infection Prevention nurse.) No siblings will be allowed to visit the newborn or the mother at this time. The dads are allowed to leave the facility and return.
- ER patients are allowed to have 1 (one) person in the room.
- Absolutely NO VISITORS for suspected positive or COVID positive patients!!!


