Gove County Medical Center wants to provide our community with an update on our current COVID-19 information. With the latest wave of the COVID delta variant, we wanted to let the public know that we are continuing to take extra measures to ensure your safety and that of our employees and residents.

It is important as a county, that we remain vigilant with hygiene, social distancing, masks and watching for symptoms. Vaccinations are still available for those wanting to receive it. If you have concerns about the vaccine, please talk with your primary care provider. If you would like to receive the vaccine, please contact the Gove County Health Department 785-754-2147.

Masks are still required at Gove County Medical Center, the Gove County Health Department and Bluestem Medical. As we see an increase in active cases of COVID across the country, regulations within all facilities are being adjusted routinely and swiftly.

Gove County Medical Center is subject to OSHA (Occupations Safety and Health Administration) rules and regulations protecting healthcare workers.
