Visitation Policy

Effective immediately, Gove County Medical Center will no longer be requiring visitors or patients to wear masks. During high transmission or outbreak testing, masks will be required in the Long Term Care but not in the hospital.

We ask that all visitors self-screen themselves before entering the facility. If you are symptomatic but have not tested positive for COVID-19, we strongly encourage you to contact your primary care provider. While we will not turn away symptomatic patients from receiving any care, we ask that you please do not enter the facility with symptoms without first putting a mask on. If you are currently positive for COVID-19, please do not enter the facility unless seeking emergency medical care.

Masks are available at the entrance and upon request. Gove County Medical Center strongly encourages masks but is not requiring them at this time.

For the provision of care, Gove County Medical Center will not turn anyone away seeking emergency care within a Gove County Medical Center facility regardless of COVID-19 status.
